




- 1.Before assembling lighting fixtures, make sure you have electrical wiring experience or have your fixture installed by a qualified licensed electrician.
- 2. Prepare everything in a clear area.
- 3. Put on gloves all the time during this installation.
- 4. Take out fixture and glass from box.
- 5. Read instructions carefully before you assemble.




- 1. Take out a hanging bar (A) for mounting by threading two screws (B).
- 2. Then mount hanging bar (A) carefully to junction box by using the two screws (C) provided.




two collector cable bands.







- 1. Determine the over all length you need the assembled fixture to be.
- 2.Adjust the fixture height: To extend the length by releasing the cord (E) or shorten the cord (E) by pressing (F), then release (F) to lock and fasten the wire.



1.Use a collector cable band to tighten the pendant cord (E) above ceiling canopy.



- 1.Before starting the electrical installation, make sure to turn off the power.
- 2. Checking the ceiling canopy in accordance with local electrical codes before making all connections.
- 3. To connect the two black fixture wire (G) to the hot 120 volt power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4. Than to connect the white fixture wire \bigoplus to the neutral 120 volt power line wire with a wire nut.
- 5. Carefully to tread on both ball knobs (J)x2 and screws (I)x2 to secure ceiling canopy (K) to the ceiling.



1. Fixture can now be lamped accordingly.
