Flush Mount Led

Please Note:

• All Kuzco LED fixtures come with pre-wired LED module(s).

• Unless instructed to do so, please do not touch any part of the LED module(s) as any unnecessary contact with the module could cause permanent damage.

• For dimming, an ELV (Electronic Low Voltage) dimmer is required.

Remove the fixture from its original packaging and remove the fixture mounting plate from within the hardware package.

Attach the fixture to the mounting plate, which is attached to the electrical junction box on the ceiling. First attach all wiring (2a) with the provided marrets (white to white "N", black to black "L", ground to ground "G"). Once this is complete you can thread on the mounting plate (2b) to the box (2c).

Anchor the fixture. Using the three holes in the fixture (4b), create registration marks on the ceiling. Turn canopy mounting plate away from registration marks and drill appropriate holes into ceiling. Now insert the plastic anchors (3a) into the ceiling.

Turn the canopy back to align canopy holes to plastic anchors, secure with scews (3b). Once this is complete you can thread on the decorative nuts (3c) to the two studs (3d) until the fixture is secured to the ceiling.


The next step is to install the glass cover (4a) onto the fixture. With one hand, push the glass (4a) up against the underside of the fixture (4b) and tighten the large decorative nut (4c) until glass is secure. Caution, do not use exsisive force when tightening.



You have now completed the installation of your fixture,

- Have your fixture installed by a qualified licensed electrician
- Prepare everything in clear area.
- Wear gloves at all times during this installation.
